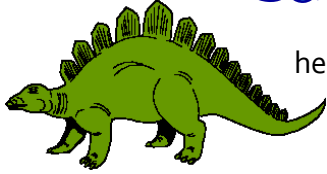

Dinosaur Roar!



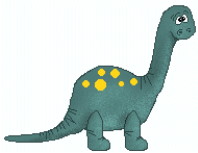
What's that sound I hear? Could it be a dinosaur?
