Below you will find a curriculum map of the subjects the children will be taught within this half term topic alongside the activities and learning opportunities within this subject. We hope that by providing you with details of what your child is learning at school, you can help to support your child's learning at home and recreate some of the fun learning your child is experiencing at school.

English

The children will be writing letters to Miss. Kelly to explain about the wonders of Redditch.

We will be applying the use of writing with conjunctions and suffixes across a range of writing.

This half term will also see the introduction of our new cursive handwriting style so we will be learning and applying this ready for year 3.

DT and Science

We will be planning an end of year party where we will need to make the food to eat. We will look at keeping healthy and minimising germs through an exciting investigation.

Music

The children will continue to learn new melodies to play on their ocarinas. We will focus on breathing and using the correct finger positions.

P.E

Athletics and practising for sports dy events will be the focus for this half term. We will also continue to develop our tennis skills and play mini games within our classes.

Maths

The children will be developing their knowledge of fractions of shapes and number ina practical context and moving towards using written strategies to find halves and quarters of numbers.

We will aslo be recapping our work on telling time. This will include telling the analogue time to the quarter of the hour and 5 minute intervals. We will then nuse this knowledge to solve problems.

PSHE

The children will be discussing the relationships they have. We will talk about how we can be a good friend to others and who we can turn to if we are worried or need help with something. We will aso discuss how we can be our own best friend by believing in ourselves and our abilities.



RE

The focus will be on caring for our world. We will be exploring the stories from Islam, Judaism and Christaianity that focus on caring for others. We will retell the story of the Good Samaritan and explain how the message can be used in our lives today.

Redditch has an interesting past and the children will explore vistorian Redditch and use maps and photographs to identify how Redditch has changed over time.
