

At Oak Hill we are always trying to keep our parents informed of what your child's learning in school to help you support them at home. Below you will find a curriculum map of the subjects the children will be taught within this topic half term and the activities and learning opportunities within this subject. We hope that by providing you with details of what your child is learning at school, you can help to support your child's learning at home and recreate some of the fun learning your child is experiencing at school.

Music

In music the children will be using voices to sing various songs from the singup website.

PSHE

We will be working with Jigsaw Jack and finding out what it is like to 'Be me in my world.' Where we will develop self awareness about our feelings.

Computing

We will be focusing how to log on and use a laptop to open and use simple drawing and word processing programmes. We will use the I pads to support our learning in phonics and guided reading and to record the work we do. We will look at simple coding to carry out sequences by coding each other as well as using the beebots.

Art

We will be creating monsters; monster machines; collages; maps etc. associated with our monster theme through drawing, painting and sculpture. We will be using the following techniques to do this: colour, pattern, texture, line, shape, form and space.

PE
