We will support the children to develop their vocabulary to talk about themselves, their families and things that are important to them.

We will also be encouraging them to join in with different songs and rhymes.

The next few weeks are mainly about settling the children in, becoming familiar with nursery routines and most importantly, having fun! We will be encouraging the children to

Physical Development

With all of our children, we will be encouraging independence with toileting and hand washing. We will be looking at how to look after ourselves.

Children will be learning to use different equipment (both large and small, inside and outside) and exploring different ways of moving using different parts of their bodies.

Mathematics

We will be using the different parts of our bodies (eyes and hair colour, fingers, toes etc) to explore the language of size, sorting by different criteria and counting.

We will be singing lots of counting songs and encouraging the children to say some number names in sequence.

Expressive Arts and Design

We will be exploring lots of different materials to make self-portraits and pictures of our families.

We will be going on listening walks and listening to the sounds in our environment as well as exploring different music and instruments.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

The early days in nursery are about helping the children to feel safe and happy. We will be talking about how to be kind at nursery and how to make lots of new friends.
