Staying Comfortable

We have all enjoyed the lovely summer but the days will soon be getting colder. The children need to come to nursery with a warm, waterproof coat and sturdy shoes so that they can make the most of all the exciting learning opportunities in our amazing new outdoor area. Please label all your child's belongings to avoid items being lost. Some children already bring a bag of spare clothes to nursery in case they need changing and this is a really good idea.



Staying Safe

If you have arranged for your child to be picked up by a different adult than usual, please make sure that you inform nursery staff so we know who to expect.

Timings

Please make sure that you are on time to drop off and collect your child.

Morning session – 8.30am drop off

11.30am **PROMPT** collection

Afternoon session – 12.15pm **PROMPT** drop off

3.15pm collection

If parents have not collected their child by 11.40am/ 3.25pm they will be taken down to the main office and they can be collected from there.

If you know you will be late please inform one of the nursery staff or the main school office.

Forms

Please make sure that you have signed all of the relevant admission forms and documentation and handed it to the office by the date that your child is due to start.

If we have not received this paper work along with the birth certificate, your child will not be able to start Nursery.

How can I support my child at home?

Encourage your child to begin to manage their own personal hygiene as independently as possible. Allow them to go to the bathroom on their own and wash their hands afterwards.

If children are still not toilet trained, begin to encourage them to use the toilet at home and we can do the same at nursery. They are big boys and girls after all! 😊
