
It's all about reading!

You can help at home by allowing your child to dress themselves, showing them how to turn clothes the right way out and how to put on socks and tights.

Now the weather is changing please make sure your child brings a coat to school every day.


Also check school uniforms and P.E. kits are labelled with your child's name or initials.
