Here at Oak Hill, children from Reception to Year 4 are encouraged to participate in a variety of different visits both locally and further afield. We use the local environment and surrounding resources to give the children first hand historical, geographical and physical experiences including visits to the library, the Arrow Valley Lake, weekly swimming, places of worship, local museums and art galleries.

Each year group will go on a trip further afield, appropriate to their age including Twycross Zoo and London. Year 4 annually go on a residential trip which fosters rich opportunities for team building, self-esteem and independence.
