Design Technology

As designers, we will be exploring different materials and using different cutting and joining techniques to create a Roman chariot.

History

As historians we will be focussing on how the Roman Empire has had an impact on Britain today. We will be asking lots of questions and be using a range of sources to gain information.

Computing


As computer scientists we will be using coding as a tool to control movement and create sequences.

Art

As artists we will be looking at Roman mosaics which will help us when designing and creating our own.

English

We will be collecting lots of information on the impact of Romans in Britain to be able to create a non-chronological report on Roman life. We will also be reading 'Escape from Pompeii' and exploring the life of the different characters.

As mathematicians we will be working on our knowledge of multiplication and applying our measuring skills into real life contexts when we create our Roman chariots. We will also be exploring Roman numerals and learning how to recognise these numbers.
