Don't leave your Christmas presents on display in the house or car

Cyber Crime: If an online purchase seems too good to be true, it probably is!

#becybersmart

S: Safeguard your payment. Never transfer money directly into the seller's account. Pay by card on a secure payment page, by cheque or cash in person.

M: Make sure payment pages are secure and you can see and or in the browser window.

A: A credit card, rather than a debit card, gives you more chance of getting your money back if there are problems.

R: Remember Wi-Fi in public places is not always secure - even if you have to enter a code.

T: Think. After you have finished your online shopping or banking session remember to log out.

Freeze out car thieves on frosty mornings:

Although vehicle crime is low across Warwickshire and West Mercia, cars are stolen from driveways every winter because owners leave them unattended, with the keys in the ignition, while they warm up and the windscreens defrost.

Some vehicle owners nip inside for just a few seconds to collect a bag or finish the last mouthful of coffee – but that's all the time an opportunist thief needs.

Insurance companies may not pay out for cars stolen in this way – and if your house keys are taken as well, you're making your home vulnerable.
