Dear parents/ carers,

Re: Bumblebee Nursery Group Drop off and Collection.

In response to the recent parent questionnaires, we will be making some changes to the way that the children are dropped off and collected from Nursery over the next few weeks.

As you are aware, it gets very congested at busy times of the day and we need to make some changes that ensure the safety of our children.

Drop off - After half term, children will be asked to line up outside of the nursery at 8.30am (there will be a sign indicating where the children need to line up). The nursery staff will collect the children from the nursery garden and bring them into nursery and help with coats and bags where needed. This will ease the congestion in the cloak room and will encourage our children to be more independent, in readiness for school. Mrs Weller will remain on the door for those children that arrive at nursery after 8.30am. These children will still be encouraged to come into nursery independently.

Collection - We have already started a slightly different collection routine in the morning and we will be rolling it out in the afternoon. Parents will be asked to wait outside of the nursery doors at the end of the day and the children will wait in the cloakroom, in their family group. A member of staff will call your child and send them out to you. This will now be a permanent part of the children's routine as we feel that it is much more manageable and safer for the children. Staff will still be available for you to speak to if you wish. We will be placing the book box outside (on dry days) so that your child can still change their reading books whenever they like.

If you have any comments or feedback on the changes, please feel free to speak to Mrs Weller, the class teacher.
