Dear Parents/Carers,

Our children enjoy spending time outdoors, but their skin is more delicate than ours and can easily be damaged by the sun, even when it doesn't seem strong. In school, your child has been learning to stay safe in the sun using three simple steps - **Wrap, Splat, Hat**. Here are some easy steps to help you protect your child:

- Make sure that your child Wraps up in a t-shirt, Splats on sun cream with a minimum SPF50, and puts on a Hat!
- Provide them with sunglasses to protect their eyes and a water bottle to keep them hydrated.
- Talk to your child about sun safety and the importance of being responsible.

How do I enter?

Tips

- Think about what your hat would be made from – which materials might be most suitable? You could describe these in your labels.
- Think about the shape of your hat – does it protect the head, face and neck?
- Think about style – if your hat looks great, people will be more likely to want to wear it!
- Practise any pattern ideas on rough paper before adding them onto your design.
- Think about how you could make your hat design stand out from the rest.
