## YEAR 4 RESIDENTIAL VISIT – ACADEMIC YEAR 2019- 2020



In Year 4 we arrange a highly successful annual residential course each year. Following our fantastic visit to Condover Hall in Shropshire this year, we are very pleased to announce that we will return in September 2019. Condover is run by the JCA group, who have over 20 years experience of providing quality residential trips across the UK, and is a state of the art residential activity centre. At Condover, the children will work in small groups on a range of activities and will benefit from an instructor who stays with them throughout the visit, building confidence and a trusting relationship. As with all our previous trips, we are sure the

children will thoroughly enjoy themselves; benefiting enormously in terms of maturing, learning new skills, becoming more independent and gaining responsibility.



We feel that the children benefit greatly by going on this trip at the beginning of the academic year, enabling the building of really strong positive relationships between teachers and pupils, that will stand them in good stead for the rest of the year.

The trip will run from Wednesday 18<sup>th</sup> September – Friday 20<sup>th</sup> September 2019 and this opportunity is open to our current Year 3 pupils. The total cost of the visit, including transport cost, has been calculated at the very competitive price of £150.50.

### **Costing Breakdown:**

Condover Hall - £135.50

Transport - £15.00

Total cost = £150.50

To support this educational visit, our Governors have allocated a proportion of school fund in order to pay for the £15.00 transport costs for each child.

Therefore, the total payment for parents/carers = £135.50

Further details about the payment schedule using Parent Pay will be sent out soon, with a £25.00 deposit needed by Friday 16<sup>th</sup> November in order to secure your child's place on the visit. Please note that we are unable to accept payments after this date.

We know you will want to find out more about the visit and have therefore arranged a short session for parents on Thursday 18<sup>th</sup> October 2018 at 3.15pm in the school hall. All children are welcome to come and join the meeting.
