

At Oak Hill we always keep our parents informed of what the children are learning in school in order to help you support them at home. Below you will find a curriculum map of the subjects the children will be taught this half term .

### Design Technology

The children have been contacted by their client, The Wizard of Fairy Tale Forest. He has requested some help to rehouse animals that have lost their home. The children will be designing and making birdhouses for the birds to live in. They will be constructing their box with a wooden frame and using a hacksaw to cut the wood pieces to size.

### Geography

Animals in Fairy Tale Forest have lost their homes so the children have been asked by their client to find a new place for them to live. We will be exploring the local area using maps and doing fieldwork to consider how the land is used. The children will be identifying the best location that has a large area of trees for shelter and water for the animals to drink so that they can survive.

### Science

We will be working for our client to find a suitable location to rehouse the animals that have lost their home. Year 2 will be finding out about the woodland habitat and identifying the animals and plants that live there.



## Fairy Tale Forest



### Computing

We will be reviewing our e-safety rules to consider how to stay safe online. This half term the children will also be writing their own coding using Scratch Junior software. They will be exploring how to make characters move in different ways.

### Religious Education

This half term the children will be developing their understanding of what Muslims believe.

### English

Year 2 will apply their knowledge of nouns and adjectives to write a character description of a fairy tale character. We will be studying the story of Little Red Riding Hood. The children will be using their skills of how to use different punctuation such as commas, question marks and exclamation marks to write their own version of the fairy tale.

### Maths

This half term the children will be identifying the number of tens and ones in a 2 digit number. They will be using base 10 resources to explore how to partition numbers in different ways. Year 2 will then use their understanding of place value to learn how to add numbers. We will be exploring different addition skills including mental strategies and using column method to add two numbers together.

### Music

We will be listening to pieces of music to identify how sounds change for effect. The children will also be creating sound effects for our fairy tale story.

### PE

The children will be working on co-operation in Dodgeball sessions. In Dance lessons they will explore moving in time and with control.

### Art

The children will be developing their painting skills by exploring the colour wheel.
